## Henry County Health Department Reports First COVID-19 Death

**Napoleon, OH** – It is with great sadness, Henry County Health Department is confirming the first death of a Henry County resident due to COVID-19. The deceased individual is a male in his 80s. No additional information will be provided in order to protect personal privacy.

"We extend our deepest condolences to the family and friends of this resident," stated Mark Adams, Health Commissioner. "This is an unfortunate reminder of how serious COVID-19 can be and why it's so important to continue following public health guidance to prevent the virus from spreading."

As of July 27, 2020, 90 cases of COVID-19 had been confirmed in Henry County. The majority of cases in Henry County are not related and therefore considered community spread, meaning the virus is circulating throughout our county.

Symptoms of COVID-19 may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. Symptoms include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Every resident can greatly limit the spread of COVID-19 by following these actions:

1. Follow the statewide mask mandate. All individuals in Ohio must wear facial coverings in public at all times when: At an indoor location that is not a residence; Outdoors, but unable to maintain six-foot social distance from people who are not household members; Waiting for, riding, driving, or operating public transportation, such as a taxi, a car service, or a private car used for ride-sharing.

- 2. Maintain social distancing of at least six feet. Be respectful of other people and the space around them indoors or out.
- 3. Decrease in-person interactions with others outside of your household and limit attending gatherings of any size.
- 4. Wash your hands frequently with soap and warm water and encourage those around you to do the same.
- 5. Stay home if you feel ill. If you are concerned it may be COVID call your healthcare provider.
